Residents of Experimental Township Give Talks in Bay Area

San Jose, California – On Saturday, September 11 at the Indo-American Community Service Center in Santa Clara from 11:15am to 1:00pm, and again on Sunday, September 12 at the Youth Center Vedic Dharma Samaj of Fremont from 1:00pm to 2:00pm, Guy Ryckaert and Ruth Elisabeth Hauser will give an informal talk on the growth and development of Auroville, India, where they are residents.

Auroville is an international township based on the spiritual philosophy of Sri Aurobindo, dedicated to international understanding, and human unity, a cornerstone of the city charter. Auroville was founded in 1968 near the city of Pondicherry, India. The project has been endorsed by several unanimous resolutions of UNESCO as well as the government of India.

Today, Auroville is an expanding community of about 1,500 people from some 30 countries around the world. It has become a veritable "laboratory for a sustainable planet," with residents doing pioneering work in wasteland reclamation, soil and water conservation, reforestation work, organic farming. Their work has been instrumental in reintroducing sustainable agriculture throughout the bioregion and has established Auroville as a major testing ground for renewable energy sources.

Auroville also runs nurseries, kindergartens, and schools for the children of the nearby villages. The talk will include ways that we can participate in this historical project which is presently endangered by uncontrolled land speculation and development.

The talks are part of a USA tour, culminating on September 22, when Guy and Ruth will speak at the 11th Annual International Conference of the Society for Ecological Restoration, at the Presidio in San Francisco, a global conference hosted by SER and Earth Island Institute which runs from September 23 through 25.

There are several other engagements in the Bay area this month, including a benefit concert of Indian classical music on Sunday evening, September 19 in Fremont. Everyone is welcome.
